Terms of reciprocal admission are at the discretion of each participating institution. Museums located within 90 miles of each other are not required to participate in the free reciprocal admission program, or they may offer discounted admission to eligible members of ASTC institutions within 90 miles. We recommend calling ahead to learn the reciprocal admission policy of the museum you wish to visit.

Free or discounted admission at reciprocal institutions pertains to general admission only—it does **NOT** include: free or discounted admission to planetariums, theater presentations, or special exhibits; store or parking discounts; or any other benefits associated with membership, unless expressly stated.
