## About Chicago Children's Museum

The mission of Chicago Children's Museum (CCM) is to create a community where play and learning connect. Since 1982, CCM has offered young children what few institutions can—the freedom to lead with their imaginations and learn without limitations. The museum's primary audience is children through age 10, their families, caregivers, and educators. Through hands-on exhibits, child-centered educational programming, and innovative community engagement programs, CCM gives children opportunities to learn, face challenges and develop new understandings of the world around them.

## How You can Join the Fun

Corporate Volunteers help CCM serve the learning lives of children and families through a range of volunteer opportunities perfect for any size group or interest area. All Corporate Volunteers receive a comprehensive orientation, including information about the museum, program goals and tips for engaging museum visitors.

In addition to assisting with ongoing museum programs, Corporate Volunteers can participate in the following group volunteer opportunities:

**Alphapalooza (ideal for groups with 26+ volunteers):** Join us and represent a letter of the alphabet. Museum visitors collect stamps after solving riddles about items that start with each volunteer's letter. After visitors collect all 26 letters of the alphabet, they turn in their stamp books to receive a prize!

**Collect-A-Color (ideal for groups with 10-15 volunteers):** Collect-a-color is an engaging activity that encourages children to think creatively. Volunteers represent colors of the rainbow while visitors collect matching beads from volunteers after solving riddles, answering questions or being creative. Once visitors collect all of the different color beads, they can craft their collection into a bracelet or keychain.

**Number Rhumba (ideal for groups of 10 volunteers):** Help kids understand wellness by representing a number and promoting health. Visitors collect wellness cards from volunteers by answering questions about health and wellness or by doing something active. After all cards are collected, visitors receive a prize!

### 10 Steps to Fire Safety (ideal for groups of 10-12 volunteers)

Help our visitors learn fire safety skills through this informational, engaging program. Volunteers lead visitors through 10 fire safety challenges while collecting tips and guidelines along the way. After all 10 challenges are completed, visitors receive a Junior Firefighter badge and a fire safety coloring book to take home.
