<b>Pritzker Playspace</b>	Join an open playgroup that's exclusively for babies, toddlers, preschoolers – meet other families, get inspired and play! <i>(Limited hours; please see Today's Events fliers throughout museum)</i>
<b>WaterWays</b>	Use your senses as you play in the water and paint on the water wall.
<b>Michael's Museum</b>	A Curious Collection of Tiny Treasures: Explore the materials, look at the collection, open up drawers and see a surprise!
<b>BIG Backyard</b>	Stretch out in the baby pond, crawl through the sensory shoe, ring the flower bells and play with your shadow.
<b>Treehouse Trails</b>	Play on the soft play-scape, cruise along the stream, hide in the tent and send balls rolling down the ramp.
<b>Kids Town</b>	Crawl, cruise and discover surprises in the crawlspace, explore the grocery store and play with blocks and trucks.
<b>Tinkering Lab</b>	Scoop, pour, stack and sort a variety of everyday materials presented in surprising ways.
