LEVEL 2

Adaptable, play-based math strategies and resources for Chicago K – 1 teachers

Playing with Numbers Level 2 (PWN 2) is a selective, fully-funded professional development program for K – 1 educator teams who have previously completed the first level of the PWN program.

Designed by Chicago Children's Museum education experts, PWN 2 builds on the goals and instructional strategies from the first year.

■ PWN 2 deepens your practice.

PWN 2 provides structure and support that allows you to sustain your learning from PWN 1. It strengthens your understanding of math work stations, literacy and math integration, and the use of hands-on activities during math instruction.

■ PWN 2 helps you set (and reach) new goals.

You won't just learn about PWN instructional strategies and resources, you'll collaborate and reflect on your practices in order to come up with challenging new goals.

■ PWN 2 provides advanced instructional strategies and materials at no cost to teachers.

PWN 2 materials build on those from PWN 1. Plus, the innovative classroom activities, math work stations, and children's literature are all free.

■ PWN 2 is an investment in your career—and your students.
